## Curtin University –Perth, Australia

### Master of Health Administration

Admission Requirements: A basic qualification at degree level or equivalent in an appropriate profession together with work experience in a health administration field.

Course Requirements: 2 years of full-time study for 12 courses. Courses include Health Economics, Health Services Financial Management, and Health Research Methods.

Total Annual Course Fees (Australian Dollars 2008): \$21,900

### Graduate Certificate in International Health

Admission Requirements: Bachelor's degree or equivalent.

Course Requirements: 1 semester full-time of 4 courses. Courses include International Health and Primary Healthcare, Maternal and Child Health in Developing Countries, and Medical Geography.

Total Annual Course Fees (Australian Dollars 2008): \$11,400

## Deakin University - Melbourne, Australia

### Graduate Diploma of Health Promotion

Admission Requirements: Completion of 3-year undergraduate degree.

Course Requirements: 1-year of full time study. Eight 1-point credit units; 6 core units and 2 elective units.

Total annual course fees (Australian dollars 2008): \$18,460

### Master of Public Health

Admission Requirements: Undergrad degree and 2 years prof. exp.

Course Requirements: 1.5 years of full-time study. A 12-point credit program consisting of 6 credit points of core units and 6 electives.

Total annual course fees (Australian dollars 2008): \$18,460

## Edith Cowan University - Perth, Western Australia

Admission Requirements: Undergraduate bachelor's degree and work experience required for some programs.

Offers graduate certificates in Addiction Studies, Emergency Management, Environmental Health, Health & Ecology, Health Promotion, Health Services Management, Occupational Safety & Health, Public Health, and Women's Health.

Total Annual Course Fees (Australian Dollars 2008): approx. \$9,000-\$11,000

## Murdoch University - Perth, Western Australia

Admission Requirements: Undergraduate degree in relevant program. Some programs require professional work experience.

Offers a wide range of postgraduate and masters degrees including Counselling, Mental Health Nursing, Organisational Human Resources & Safety, Pharmacy, Psychology, Sports Science.

Program length: 12-24 months.

Total Annual Course Fees (Australian Dollars 2008): approx. \$10,000-\$22,000

## The University of Wollongong - Wollongong, Australia

Admission Requirements:

**Masters by Research:** 4-year honours bachelor degree awarded at Class II (or Division 2) in a discipline relevant to intended research degree.

**Masters by Coursework:** undergraduate degree in relevant discipline.

Postgraduate Research Degrees include Doctor of Philosophy, Doctor of Public Health and Master of Science Research.

Postgraduate Coursework Degrees include Master of Science, Master of Health Management, Master of Nutrition Management, and Master of Public Health.

Total Annual Course Fees (Australian Dollars 2009): approx \$8,000-\$11,000



## The University of Western Australia - Perth, Australia

Located in beautiful Perth, Australia, UWA is one of Australia's leading research universities.

UWA offers graduate certificates/diplomas, master's degrees, and doctorates for a wide range of programs in the field health science.

### Graduate Certificate/Diploma (6-12 months)

Courses: clinical epidemiology, health professional education, health studies, paediatric respiratory/rheumatology/sleep science, public health, rural medicine, dental studies/education studies, dental public/primary health, dentistry, forensic odontology, neurological rehabilitation, primary care psychiatry, sports manual therapy.

Admission requirements: a bachelor's degree in a related health discipline.

### Master's (1-4 semesters)

Courses: clinical epidemiology, clinical research, dental public/primary health, dental science, emergency medicine, health professional education, laboratory medicine, manual therapy, nursing research, public health, rural medicine.

### Graduate Diploma in Health Sciences

Admission Requirements: Bachelors Degree and at least 2 years relevant work experience.

Course Requirements: completion of 120 points of taught courses over two full-time semesters (1 year). Specialisation offered in Managed Care.

Total Annual Course Fees (New Zealand Dollars 2008): \$30,121

### Masters of Health Sciences

Admission Requirements: Completion of requirements for Postgraduate Diploma in Health Sciences (or equivalent) with a B average.

Course Requirements: completion of 120 points of taught courses over two full-time semesters (1 year) or part-time over 2 years.

Total Annual Course Fees (New Zealand Dollars 2008): \$30,121

## The University of Glasgow – Glasgow, Scotland

Offers masters programs and post graduate diplomas in various fields of health science including both taught and research programs.
