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Trinity College Dublin - Ireland

Master in Business Administration (M.B.A.) - 1 year full time/two years part time
Closing date June 2010

This programme attracts participants of diverse backgrounds worldwide to the strong general management offering. The intensity of the programme encourages concentration and focus while allowing career-minded individuals to earn the M.B.A. with a relatively short break from their working career. This is a boutique programme, geared to serve around 30 students each year. The programme is based on tutorial model and provides great flexibility and responsiveness to individuals' needs and goals. Entry Requirements: A good undergraduate degree with at least three years work experience



Curtin University of Technology - Perth, Australia

MBA – 1.5 years

Entry requirements: A bachelor degree or equivalent, plus at least three years' relevant work experience.



Deakin University - Melbourne, Australia

MBA – 1.5 years

The MBA offers a world renowned leadership qualification. It is designed for mid-level managers who want to extend their knowledge to advance their careers. Ambitious executives typically find the MBA a challenging and rewarding experience. The wide diversity of student backgrounds provides MBA graduates with an extensive and varied network.

Entry requirements: A three-year bachelors degree and a minimum of two years of relevant work experience, or completion of the Graduate Diploma of Business Administration or Graduate Certificate of Business Administration.



MBA International – 1.5 years

Our course aims to develop business managers, particularly business managers operating in an international context, with the capability of dealing with all aspects of an organization's management. It is especially designed for those who have yet to gain significant work experience in business. You will develop astute and informed leadership skills, with an emphasis being placed on interpersonal skills and exposure to business practice. The capacity for you to deliver innovative and feasible business strategies will be developed and you will gain a sound understanding of the principles of management appropriate to the international business environment.

Entry requirements: A three-year bachelors degree or equivalent with a minimum grade point average of 65%

Edith Cowan University - Perth, Australia



MBA – 1.5 years

The Master of Business Administration program is designed to develop essential managerial knowledge, skills and attitudes which will enable graduates to be effective and productive in the workplace. The fundamental theme of the course is managerial decision-making within the context of the manager's interpersonal and informational roles.

Entry requirements: A recognized undergraduate degree or graduate certificate or graduate diploma and subject to a minimum of two years relevant professional experience.

MBA International – 1.5 years

This course enables graduates and suitably qualified non-graduates to complete a postgraduate degree designed to provide a broad knowledge base and the management skills required for success in operating international businesses.

Flexibility in the course allows for adaptation for particular client or industry groups.

Entry requirements: A recognized undergraduate degree or a minimum of five years relevant professional experience with at least two years in a managerial capacity.

Murdoch University - Perth, Australia



MBA– 1 year

The Master of Business Administration is designed to provide a comprehensive exposure to the analytical tools required to make sound business decisions, as well as to enable students to develop in-depth skills in such areas as accounting, marketing, environmental management, electronic business, finance and general management. The contact time is comparable to other Australian and international MBA courses. Classes are usually held in the evening as it is much more convenient for working professionals.

Entry requirements: A recognized Bachelor's degree or higher plus at least two years of relevant practical work experience, or equivalent training, or satisfactory preparation through previous study or professional experience.

University of Wollongong - Wollongong, Australia



MBA– 1.5-2 years

The Master of Business Administration is designed for experienced professionals who wish to develop their managerial skills in order to operate effectively in an increasingly competitive and evolving global business environment. Our program is designed for those who are qualified in a specialized field and who wish to develop their business acumen and business skills. Master of Business Administration students develop a portfolio of key management competencies that range from strategic analysis and decision-making skills through to an appreciation of global business challenges, complemented by people, financial, marketing and system analysis skills.

Entry requirements: a Bachelor degree or equivalent with minimum average of 60%, along with a minimum of two years full-time relevant professional or managerial work experience.

University of Western Australia - Perth, Australia



MBA – 4 trimesters

The intent of the MBA is to expose you to the full range of management functional areas to provide you with the relevant skills and a conceptual framework which you may later reinforce with further on-the-job management experience.

Entry requirements: An approved Bachelor's degree, 2 years relevant work experience, and satisfactory performance in a UWA-approved test for English.

MBA International – 5 trimesters

Increasingly Business School students are employed in high-level positions in multinational organizations. This degree will provide specialization in international business and will require you to acquire structured international study experience prior to graduation. In addition to MBA at least two units must form an approved international program overseas.

Entry requirements: An approved Bachelor's degree, 2 years relevant work experience, and satisfactory performance in a UWA-approved test for English.

LaTrobe University - Melbourne, Australia



MBA – 15 months

This course is designed to enhance students' existing skills, and to increase their potential for creating value in the world of business and/or to meet the priorities of government organizations. The aims of the course are to provide participants with an education in the essential techniques of management; to extend this fundamental knowledge into various areas of specialization; and to achieve a balance between academic rigour and exposure to a wide variety of experience in commerce, industry and government. The major areas of study include organizational behaviour, electronic commerce, finance, human resource management, international business, management and marketing.

Entry requirements: An Australian Bachelor's degree in any discipline, or an approved international equivalent, and at least two years postgraduate work experience. Applicants who have completed a Graduate Diploma in Business Administration elsewhere may receive full Advanced Standing (credit) and gain direct entry.

University of Auckland - Auckland, New Zealand



MBA – 2 years

The Auckland MBA is aimed at professionals in their early to mid-thirties, who are currently in middle management roles and are looking to enhance their executive skills. This maximizes the opportunities for you to share your experience and aspirations with your peers in a stimulating environment. The Auckland MBA is taught on two weekday nights, for ten consecutive weeks per quarter. Entry to this stream normally follows completion of a Postgraduate Diploma in Business with a B+ or better average. If you are following this route, you will normally complete your Postgraduate Diploma in Business over two years, one course per quarter. Then you will complete the second half of your MBA in Year 3. Direct entry is also possible if you meet the entry criteria.

University of Strathclyde - Glasgow, Scotland



MBA – 1 year

The Strathclyde Master of Business Administration (MBA) is an internationally recognized management qualification aimed at talented, ambitious and well-qualified people with solid business experience. In particular it: thoroughly prepares you for higher level, policy-forming positions, allows you to make a successful career move from one field or industry to another, allows a smooth progression from a technical specialism to general management, polishes the skills and enhances the abilities of people working for themselves or about to set up in business.

Entry requirements: Undergraduate degree and minimum 3 years work experience.

University of Glasgow - Glasgow, Scotland



MBA – 1 year

Our MBA has been renewed to ensure it retains its position at the forefront of business and management education. Your learning will be facilitated through experience based approaches, focusing on practical problem-solving and exposing you to real world situations that help to challenge your assumptions, and make you a stronger, more creative manager. The Glasgow MBA program integrates the core disciplines of modern business – strategy, economics, accountancy and finance, marketing and managing people – not just with each other, but also with other critical themes and disciplines, with insights drawn from across the university and beyond. Engagement with a range of key issues, such as the impact of technological, social and political forces on organizations, the threat of climate change, new approaches to business ethics and corporate responsibility, and the role of the media, are therefore at the heart of the program.

Entry requirements: a good first/bachelors degree or professional equivalent. You must also have a minimum of three years managerial/supervisory work experience.
