University of Auckland - Auckland, New Zealand

Postgraduate Diploma in Medical Science

Length of Program: 1 year, full-time/4 years part-time

Admission Requirements: Completion of Degree of Bachelor of Medicine and Bachelor of Surgery (6-year programme, includes basic medical and health sciences in year one, after year four required to rotate among hospitals and practices in the Auckland region) - or an equivalent medical qualification. Must hold current registration as a Medical Practitioner in their country of domicile.

Details: For medical graduates wishing to pursue postgraduate study in a health or medically related field. Specializations include General Practice and Primary Healthcare, Paediatrics, and Palliative Care.

Masters of Medical Science

Length of Program: 1 year full-time/2 years part time

Admission Requirements: Students must have completed the requirements for the degree of Bachelor of Medicine, Bachelor of Surgery (or an equivalent medical qualification) and Postgraduate Diploma in Medical Science or BHB (Hons) degree. Must hold current registration as a Medical Practitioner in their country of domicile.

Details: Courses include Thesis, Research Portfolio, and Dissertation.

Doctor of Medicine

Length of Program: TBD

Admission Requirements: Applicants are required to be medical graduates of the University of Auckland or be medical graduates of other universities who are staff of the Faculty of Medical and Health Sciences.

Details: The Doctor of Medicine is an unsupervised research degree by thesis. The degree is usually, but not necessarily, based on clinical research work, which may be undertaken within or outside the University and may report research that has already been published in the primary literature. Applicants need to submit the thesis within five years of the date on which the title and thesis outline were approved and may not submit work for the MD until five years after completing the MBChB

The University of Western Australia - Perth, Aus.

Masters of Medical Science

Length of Program: 2 years

Admission Requirements: ISAT - All international applicants are required to sit the International Student Admissions Test (ISAT). Applicants need to have sat the ISAT prior to June 30 in order to be eligible for UWA 2009 entry.

Academic- All applicants need to meet the minimum academic requirement in order to remain in consideration for a place. Minimum academic requirements are equivalent to a WA TER of 96.0 for school leaver applicants and equivalent to a Grade Point Average (GPA) of 5.5 on a 0-7 scale for non-school leavers. A recognised bachelor's degree in the area of medicine and surgery is also required.

Interview- All applicants need to attend a structured interview. International students residing in Australia and New Zealand must attend their interview in Perth in person. Applicants residing outside of Australia may have the opportunity to be interviewed in Singapore or Malaysia instead of Perth.

Details: Specializations available include: biological sciences, clinical, paraclinical sciences, and public health.

Doctor of Medicine

Length of Program: 4 years

Admission Requirements: Same process as masters.

Details: This degree is of a higher standing than the degree of Doctor of Philosophy and is awarded for independent and original research which constitutes a substantial and distinguished contribution to the knowledge and understanding of any branch of learning with which the Faculty is concerned. The candidate's work should demonstrate a high degree of innovative thinking in terms of the development and testing of hypotheses and discovery and should be recognised as such by the scientific community.
