Master of Physiotherapy

Length of Program: 2 years and 1 semester

Admission Requirements: A relevant Bachelors degree or equivalent and have a history of above average grades. Essential pre-requisite units include completion of at least one tertiary unit in each of the following areas: Anatomy, Human Biology or Physiology, and Psychology. Desirable units include Physics, Research Methods or Evidence Based Practice and Statistics

Program Details:

"The Master of Physiotherapy course provides a fast track learning experience for talented students who already hold a degree, to gain the knowledge, skills, attitudes and behaviours expected of an entry level physiotherapist. The course has a hybrid structure using curriculum (to efficiently learn foundation knowledge) together with case studies and clinical practice (to integrate knowledge into clinical decision making). The course emphasises evidence based practice and encourages students in critical thinking. Course quality is under constant review with students participating in this review."



Master of Manipulative Therapy

Length of Program: 2 semesters

Admission Requirements: A bachelor degree, or equivalent in physiotherapy from a recognised tertiary institution and a strong academic record together with a minimum of two years of relevant clinical experience at a postgraduate level. It is essential that all students that partake in a professional masters program are registered with the Physiotherapists Registration Board of Western Australia. Applicants who enrol into a professional masters program, who do not hold a current registration with the Physiotherapists Registration Board are required to obtain temporary registration.

Program Details:

"This course focuses on dynamic contemporary Manual Therapy. This clinical program includes advanced training in disorder diagnosis, classification and management of spinal and peripheral musculoskeletal pain disorders. Clinical placements occur in both semesters and students are supervised by expert clinicians. The units include: Musculoskeletal Practice; Clinical Practice; Functional Rehabilitation, Clinical Anatomy, Pathology and Diagnosis, Physiology of Pain and Evidence Based Practice. Master of Sports Physiotherapy

Length of Program: 2 semesters

Units are taught by experienced academic staff who are respected internationally."
